Mission 529i

Before connecting any pedals to your Mission 529i, charge the battery for at least 2 hours using the supplied 12V wall charger.

The 529i is intended to be used on battery power and recharged between uses. It is not recommended to connect it to wall power while powering your pedals. Doing so may cause the 529i to automatically turn off for safety reasons. Repeatedly recharging while in use may cause permanent damage and will void the warranty.

To recharge the 529i when connected, first switch off the outputs using the ON/OFF switch. Connect the supplied 12V wall charger to the 12V IN. Once the internal battery is charged, remove the wall charger from the 12V IN and turn the outputs back on using the ON/OFF switch.

The 529i can be recharged using a USB charger or USB power bank via the USB IN connector. Recharging via USB is slower than using the 12V wall charger. The USB IN should be used for recharging the 529i only, and should be disconnected when the 529i is powering your pedals.

The 529i is intended for use with regular guitar effects pedals and not with high current modeling devices. Using such devices may cause the 529i to shutoff for safety reasons. Repeatedly attempting to power such devices use may cause permanent damage and will void the warranty. For use with high current modeling devices we recommend the Mission 529M and 529P.
